

## What is Explorify?


*Explorify is a free resource of engaging, creative science activities which has been designed to spark curiosity, discussion and debate. From video to hands-on activities, it's easy to get Explorifying!*

This programme has been used with KS2 at Ysgol Derwen to enhance science teaching but there are also resources available on the same scheme for foundation phase pupils. The activities include games and science videos with easy discussion points for home learning.

## How to access Explorify to continue science learning at home

With school closures Explorify can also be used at home. It is best for an adult to sign up (they can register as a home educator) and use it with their child.
