Foundation Phase Activities

- Design an Easter egg card.
- Egg hopscotch - using chalk or by drawing eggs onto paper, create a hopscotch for members of your family to try and complete. Who can complete the course the quickest?
- Design your own Easter egg - you can create a collage of this out of scrap materials / paper or make a recycled Easter egg using materials in your weekly recycling.
- Make a nest for an Easter chick using items from your garden or around the home. Try to make the nest as comfortable and sheltered as possible.
- Using any Ipad or computer package create a new chocolate bar design. (J2 Paint on HWB would be ideal for this.)



Key Stage Two Activities

- Create an 'egg' den: imagine you have one egg to protect, what could you use from around the home to make sure you can keep it safe in all weathers? Test out some egg shelters.
- Write a job advert for the Easter bunny - what characteristics do you need? What are the main details of your job?
- Research the Easter story and create a comic strip showing the main events of the story. <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/easter/easterstory.aspx>
- Act out your own play which must have the Easter bunny as the main character. You could write out a script and even record your play.
- Create an advert for the worlds tastiest Easter egg. You could create an advertisement jingle and even design the packaging.
- Create an egg creature - design an egg creature onto an egg if you have one or draw it out. You can also give your creature clothes or make it mythical by adding wings / horns.
